NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

Competitors through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of USDAA rules and regulations, which are hereby incorporated by reference, including, but not limited to, the following rules and conditions for submission and acceptance of entry: USDAA's official rules & regulation as amended July 1, 2009, are hereby incorporated by reference.

This test is open to all dogs at least eighteen months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's ability to perform safely, or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression.

All dogs must be registered with USDAA in order to compete in USDAA sanctioned events. Registration may be made online for a reduced fee or, registration may be made concurrently with entry to this show, a form for which is included in this Agility Test Schedule.

No leads, collars, food, toys, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course at any time, except as provided in USDAA rules and regulations.

Safety shall always be of foremost consideration at all times. Handlers through entry at this event accept full responsibility for themselves, their guests and the actions of their dogs.

Electronic timing will be used at this event.

The Organizing Committee of an event may refuse the entry of any competitor or dog for just cause should the committee views that participation by competitor or dog would be prejudicial to the sport. However, any committee so doing must notify the competitor in writing (with a copy to the USDAA office) in anticipation of or upon receipt of entry. The notice must include the reason for refusing the entry and a brief explanation of the basis for their decision. The burden of responsibility for appropriateness of such action rests solely with the host group and its Organizing Committee.

No entries shall be accepted, changed, altered or withdrawn for any reason after the closing date, except that an entrant may move up in class level as provided in the section titled "ENTRIES & CLOSING DATE" herein.

FAULT LIMITS MAY BE APPLIED in all classes for which faults are assessed. Limits, if any, shall be announced during the judges' briefings.

In the event that entries exceed levels that are deemed manageable for this event, one class each day may be rescheduled for another day or cancelled. If a class should be cancelled, a full refund for the class may be made. USDAA and/or MAAS assumes no additional liability related to reschedule or cancellation of classes for any reason.

Mismatched or incomplete pairs shall be accepted as draw entries only.

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded.

REFUNDS: There will be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date or in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of reason for such dismissal. Partial refunds (minus USDAA fees, judging fees & \$10 admin fee) for bitches in season and injured dogs will be made, provided you produce a signed letter from a licensed 3rd party veterinarian within 24 hours of the end of show; this does not include dogs that are injured during or after the trial. No entry fee will be refunded if the Test cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, Acts of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strike or any other cause beyond the control of the organizers.

All ring and judging assignments are tentative and may be adjusted based on actual entry. No refunds will be issued due to ring or judge changes.

See special conditions for Triathlon.

RETURNED CHECKS DO NOT CONSTITUTE A VALID ENTRY: In the event of unpaid entry fees due to an NSF check, MAAS may collect from the competitor within thirty (30) days of notice of NSF. If such fees are not collected within thirty (30) days of notice, MAAS will notify the USDAA of delinquency for cancellation of event results for all classes for the registration number to the delinquent entry. No reinstatement

of results is possible, and all awards must be returned, or the dog's registration may be suspended pending restitution for replacement and distribution of awards. Any unpaid fees or shortfalls must be paid prior to the start of the event or entry is canceled without recourse by owner/handler. All NSF Checks carry a \$25 penalty.

DOGS MUST REMAIN ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES, except when competing in the ring or in the warm-up jump area.

CHECKING IN AND MEASURING IN:

Check-in will be from 7:30 am to 8:00am on Friday

Check-in will be from 7:00 am to 7:30am on Saturday and Sunday. All times are tentative and subject to change. Consult your entry confirmation for schedule changes.

Check-in: All competitors must check-in at the check in table during the morning check-in time. Competitors that included a copy of their yellow (NOT BLUE!) permanent height card with their entry form may use Express check-in and you are then exempt from measuring in. At Express check in you must check yourself in and verify your Registration number. If you missed verifying it in your confirmation, this will be your final chance to do so.

Measuring-in: All dogs must be measured-in during the morning check in time except for (a) dogs jumping 26" (22" Performance), (b) dogs that have a permanent yellow height card, (c) dogs that have a blue temporary height card with three signatures confirming dog's jump height, or (d) dogs that have a check-in letter provided by the USDAA office or print out from subscriber account indicating the dog is permanently carded. In the event a dog measures up, it will run first in the higher height for all classes entered. If the dog is unprepared for this higher height, it may be run For Exhibition Only at the lower height, but no awards or qualifying scores may be earned and no change in program is permitted at check-in.

TEST SITE:

No dogs may be left unattended except when properly kenneled in designated kennel areas. Day kenneling only is permitted, unless otherwise posted at the show. USDAA and MAAS can and do not assume any liability for loss of any items left unattended. Dogs must be exercised only in designated area. Please pick up after your dog.

All tenting, kenneling and parking will be restricted to designated areas. As with all spectator venues, you are encouraged to present yourself and your dog in the best manner possible, including attire and sportsmanship. Help us to preserve such venues by following all show ground rules. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

LEVELS, DIVISIONS AND CLASSES

Two certification programs will be offered at this event – Championship and Performance. Competitors may enter both Championship and Performance Program classes for which they are eligible; however, under NO circumstance may a dog be entered in more than one level or program for any given class (i.e. Masters Jumpers may not enter any other level/program of jumpers).

NON-STANDARD CLASSES

Gamblers, Jumpers, Snooker & Pairs Relay Classes

These non-standard classes are scored and judged pursuant to the provisions of Chapters 6 & 7 of USDAA Rules and Regulations.

Pairs is now required for titling at all levels of Performance. For both programs, partners must be from the same height division. If only one dog is entered in a program/level, a partner may not be solicited from un-entered dogs or dogs from another program/level to form a qualifying pair.

TOURNAMENT CLASSES - Open to all dogs regardless of titles earned.

Grand Prix of Dog Agility® and Performance Grand PrixSM

A qualifying score is zero (0) faults. One qualifying score as described in the Rules and Regulations is required for entry in a Regional Championships where a bye into the semifinals may be earned. Two qualifying scores are required for entry in the quarterfinals at the World Championships.

Dog Agility Steeplechase ® and Performance Speed JumpingSM

One qualifying score as described in the Rules & Regulations is required for entry in Regional Championships. Two qualifying scores are required for entry in the Steeplechase Quarterfinals or the Performance Speed Jumping Semifinals at the World Championships.

Dog Agility Masters® Team Tournament & Performance Versatility PairsSM Tournament

A TEAM may be comprised of dogs from any two Championship height classes. A PAIR may be comprised of dogs from any two Performance height classes. One qualifying score as described in the complete rules is required for entry in the World Championships.

The handler of a dog entered in Team/PVP that measures up must notify the secretary immediately. If the change in jump height makes the dog ineligible for the team, the secretary shall make every effort to form complete teams from dogs available. If the dog is unprepared for the higher jump height, it may run FEO; however, the team/pair shall not qualify, but the partners may compete in the individual classes for top ten points and LAA Qualifications.

If a dog is entered as a DRAW, the test secretary will attempt to match the dog with other unmatched dogs. If a complete team cannot be constructed, the team/pair shall not qualify, however the dog may

compete in the individual classes for top ten points, LAA qualifications, and Triathlon scores (see next section).

In the event of a large entry, the club reserves the right to limit the Team Relay to the top 75% of teams

The Mid-Atlantic Agility Showcase Triathlon is an Invitational event, offered for competitors in both the Championship and Performance programs, composed of three rounds.

Requirement for Invitation to Triathlon

To qualify for an invitation into the Championship Triathlon, the dog must have earned a qualifying score in a Grand Prix or Steeplechase class at any USDAA event (including the Mid-Atlantic Agility Showcase) between the dates of April 2, 2009 and April 2, 2010, inclusive. To qualify for an invitation into the Performance Triathlon, the dog must have earned a qualifying score in a Performance Grand Prix or Performance Speed Jumping class also between the dates of April 2, 2009 and April 2, 2010, inclusive.

A dog may be entered into the Triathlon if they are not already qualified based on the expectation they will earn a qualifying score on or before April 2, 2010. In the case where the dog is entered into the Triathlon but does not subsequently meet the invitational requirement, 50% of the entry fee will be refunded to the competitor.

Triathlon Description

To enter the Triathlon, the dog must be entered either as a team entrant or a draw in the Dog Agility Masters Team or Performance Versatility Pairs tournaments in the Mid-Atlantic Agility Showcase.

Triathlon Round 1 scores are taken from the Team/PVP Standard class (point basis of 130 minus the dog's time plus faults). Triathlon Round 2 scores are taken from the Team/PVP Jumpers class (point basis of 100 minus the dog's time plus faults). Scores from Rounds 1 and 2 are combined in order to determine advancement into Round 3. Triathlon Round 3 is limited to the top 50% of entrants or 5 dogs, whichever is greater, in each jump height.

Rules for Triathlon Round 3 are as follows: This round is judged under Masters rules. The course is a Masters level design consisting of 17 to 20 obstacles which must include one contact obstacle and one set of weave poles, as well as other obstacles chosen from the following: wing jump, wingless jump, spread jump, extended spread jump, tire jump, long jump, pipe tunnel, and chute tunnel. This round is scored time plus faults.

A score of elimination received in any round is equal to the point basis for that round.

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Competitors must be present with dogs immediately following the class in which an award is earned in order to claim prizes and awards. All prizes and awards must be claimed on the day awarded.

Maroon rosettes awarded for all qualifying scores.

Championship Division

1st-3rd Ribbons in each jump height for all classes. Pairs classes will be placed 1st-3rd in mini and open divisions.

Performance Division

1st-3rd Ribbons in all jump heights for all classes. Pairs classes will be awarded 1st-3rd in mini and open divisions.

Tournament Classes

Grand Prix/Performance Grand Prix

1st-3rd Ribbons in each jump height for Grand Prix

1st-3rd Ribbons in each jump height for Performance Grand Prix

Qualifying Ribbons for a qualifying score in Grand Prix and Performance Grand Prix

Dog Agility Masters® Team Tournament and Performance Versatility PairsSM - Prizes and awards will be made based upon overall team scores after five rounds. USDAA will provide “Gold”, “Silver” & “Bronze” medallions at local qualifying events for the three top scoring teams/pairs. Qualifying lapel pins will be awarded to each member of each qualifying team or pair.

In addition to the team tournament awards explained above, this event will be offering the following awards/prizes:

Team Tournament: Highest scoring “Rookie” team will receive a special award. To qualify for this award, at least one team member must be competing in the Starters Standard class level (i.e. not yet eligible for Advanced Standard).

PVP Tournament: Highest scoring “Rookie” team will receive a special award. To qualify for this award, at least one team member must be competing in the Performance I Standard class level (i.e. not yet eligible for Performance II Standard).

Teams competing for the Rookie award must sign up for this award at Saturday check-in in order to be eligible.

Dog Agility Steeplechase®: Prize money shall be computed based on 20% of the total entry fees to be allocated in accordance with the payout table below regardless of the size of entry in any height class. Allocable prize money to Round 2 positions that are not filled for any reason or allocable prize amounts less than \$3 shall not be paid.
